# How will we achieve this?



## ANDOVER SMALL SCHOOL

Providing a cost-effective specialist school for children and young people who can not cope in a mainstream setting. Most of these young people will be neurodivergent.

## LEARNING WITHOUT WALLS

For young people who still cannot access a school environment, provide an alternative provision with 1:1 and small group learning opportunities.



## PEER SUPPORT

Providing a safe consistent space for neurodivergent individuals, and their families, to access neurodivergent facilitated, peer support groups.



## TRAINING AND WIDER COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

Advocating with local organisations, authorities, parents/carers and health organisations to support the engagement, wellbeing and independence of neurodivergent people in our community.
